January 14, 2018 Second Sunday after Epiphany

The Epiphany of our Lord was celebrated on January 6, yet is extended by some churches into the season preceding Lent. This church season celebrates the revelation of light and knowledge revealed through Christ for the sake of the whole world (Ephesians 3). During Epiphany worshipers are illumined with an awareness of Jesus, true God and true man, while preparing for the call to discipleship that will happen in Lent.

*Call to Worship *Responsive Reading from Psalm 139:1-6, 13-18

O LORD, you have searched me and known me.
