

## Call to Confession (Psalm 24:3-8)

Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place? The one who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not trust in an idol or swear by a false god.

They will receive blessing from the Lord and vindication from God their Savior.

Such is the generation of those who seek him, who seek your face, O God of Jacob.

Create in us new and contrite hearts, that truly turning from our sins and acknowledging our brokenness, we may obtain through Christ full pardon and forgiveness. Mercifully grant that we may walk in the way of his suffering, as we also share in his resurrection; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Assurance of Pardon (Psalm 118: 1-2, 4, 16-27)

Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever.

Let Israel say: "His love endures forever."

Let all those who fear the Lord say: "His love endures forever."

The Lord's right hand has done mighty things! I will not die but live, and will proclaim what the Lord has done. The Lord has chastened me severely, but he has not given me over to death. Open for me the gates of the righteous; I will enter and give thanks to the Lord.

This is the gate of the Lord through which the righteous may enter. I will give you thanks, for you answered me; you have become my salvation. The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes. The Lord has done it this very day; let us rejoice today and be glad.

Hosanna, Lord, save us! Lord, grant us success!

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. From the house of the Lord we bless you. The Lord is God, and he has made his light shine on us.
